OFFICE

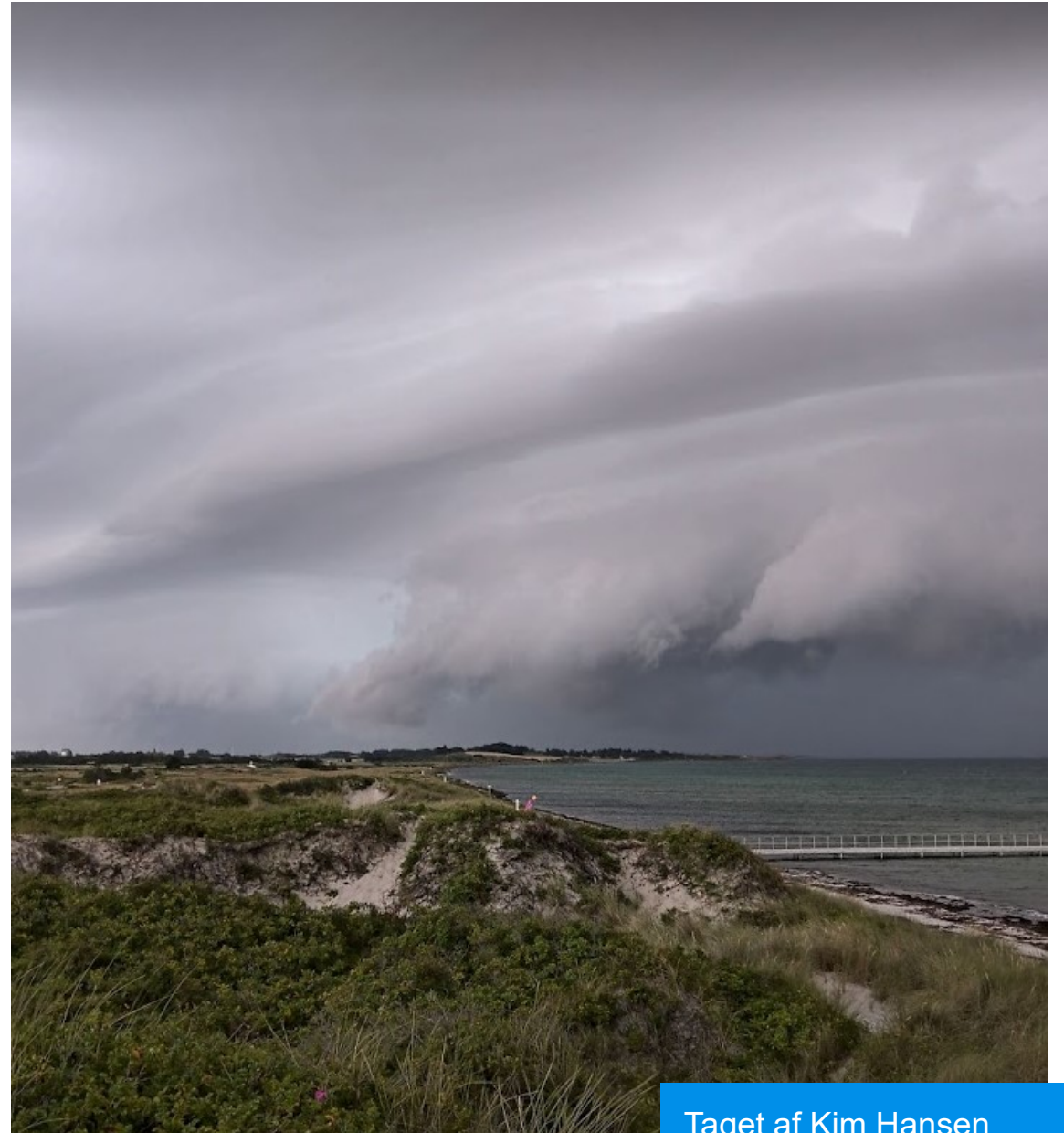
- DMI Office in Greenland moved in fall 2019 to Nuuk
